CASE 4: 5-year-old female spayed Cocker Spaniel that is drinking and peeing more. Having accidents in the house. History of urinary issues on and off. Last urinary tract infection was 1 month ago.

CASE 5: 6-month-old recently adopted female spayed cat. Sneezing and not eating well. Yellow nasal discharge found on exam. Temp: 103.4.

CASE 6: 6-year-old neutered mixed breed dog. Had surgery for a foreign body 3 days ago. Productive cough. Lethargic. Not eating well. No vomiting or diarrhea.

CASE 7: 3-year-old male neutered Frenchie. Diarrhea for a few days after eating table scraps. Acting normal. Drinking more.
